DC-5100 Laminator



Important Safety Instructions (English)

Read the following instructions thoroughly before starting up your printer.

- The device and power supply must all times be easily accessible.
- Never carry out maintenance or repair work yourself. Always contact a Dascom qualified service technician.
- Keep this user guide in a place which is easily accessible at all times.
- Place the printer on a solid and level base for reliable operation.
- Never place the printer in the vicinity of inflammable gas or explosive substances.
- Ensure the printer is connected to a socket with the correct voltage.
- Always disconnect the printer from power source before opening the device to perform maintenance work or remedy errors.
- Do not expose the printer to high temperature, direct sunlight, or dust.
- Keep all liquids away from the printer.
- Protect the printer from shock, impact and vibration.
- Make sure that both printer and computer are switched off before connecting the data cable.
- The print head will become very hot during printing; avoid contact with the print head after printing has finished.
- Do not perform any operation or action in any way other than those provided in this manual. When in doubt, contact your Dascom dealer or customer support.

- Den Drucker weder hohen Temperaturen noch direktem Sonnenlicht und Staub aussetzen.
- Keine Flüssigkeiten mit dem Drucker in Berührung bringen.
- Den Drucker keinen Erschütterungen, Stößen oder Vibrationen aussetzen.
- Sicherstellen, dass der Drucker und der Computer ausgeschaltet sind, bevor das Datenkabel angeschlossen wird.
- Der Druckkopf wird während des Druckens heiß. Vor dem Berühren deshalb einige Zeit abkühlen lassen.
- Weichen Sie bei der Bedienung des Druckers nicht von den Anweisungen in der Dokumentation ab. Bei Unklarheiten wenden Sie sich bitte an Ihren Händler oder Ihren Kundendienst.

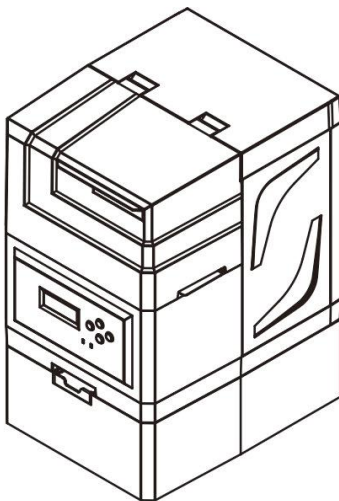

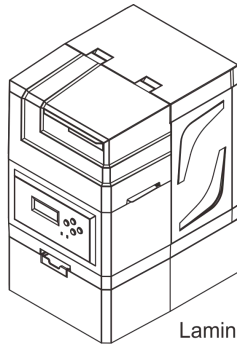

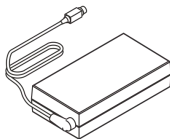
1.1 Unpacking

Open the package, take out the laminator and remove the protect material. Check if the parts and accessories in the box are complete as the following picture. If found any damage, please contact the carrier and notify your authorized Dascom re-seller to realize the steps to be taken.

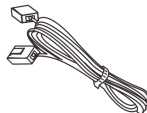

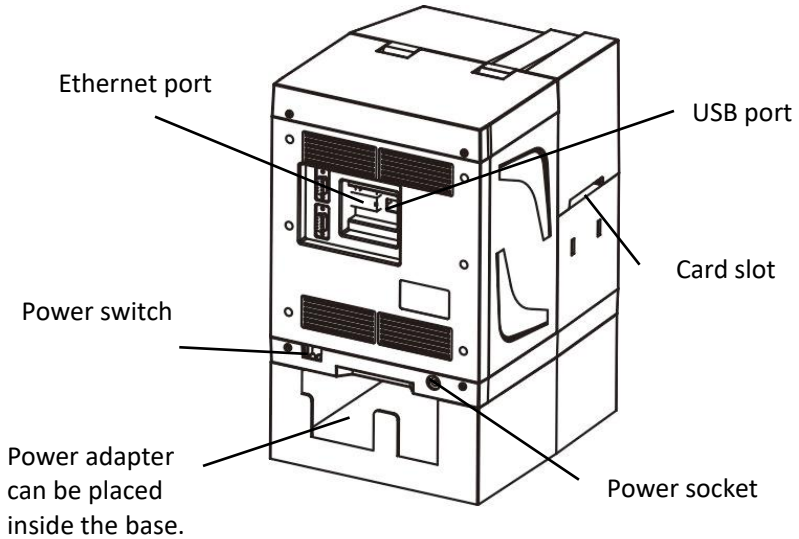
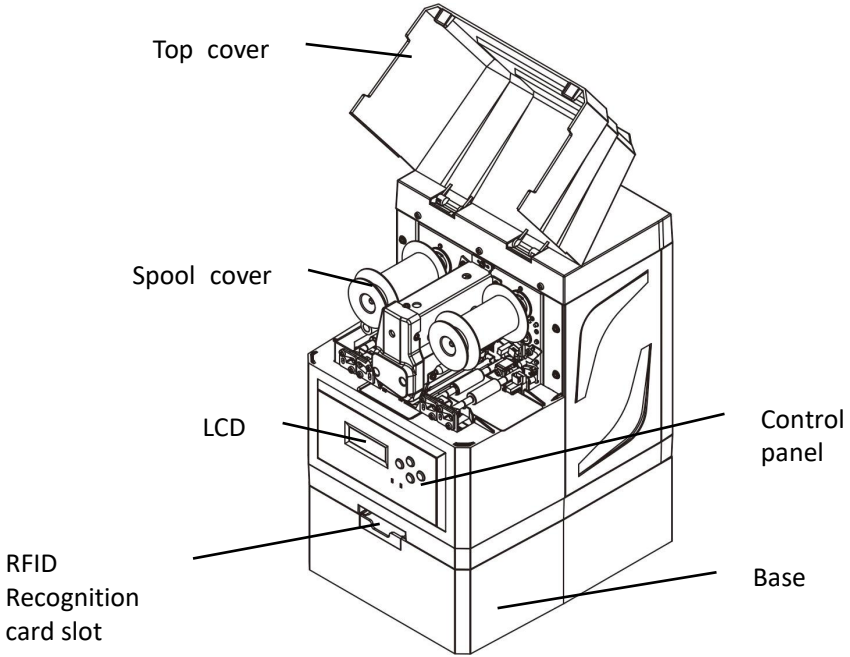
The package contents vary with different customized order requirements.

1.2 Placing the Laminator

Before installing the laminator, first of all to determine a suitable place to place it.

- Do not place the laminator on an unstable table, on a slant, or any place where there is excessive vibration.
- Do not place the laminator in a damp or dusty location.
- Connect to stable power supply, avoid using the same power supply with high power appliances such as refrigerators.
- Before unplug the power cord, turn off the laminator. Place the laminator close to the main socket for easy use.

1.3 Laminator Components



Part name	Function
Control panel	Includes the keys, LED indicators and LCD Panel, for operating the laminator.
Top cover	Open to install the film.
Port	Connect to the computer via USB port or Ethernet port.
Power socket	Used to connect the power adapter.
Power switch	Turns on and off the laminator.
RFID Recognition card slot	Used to place RFID recognition tag that is attached to the film.

1.4 Keys and LEDs

Key

There are four keys.

Position	Function
Left 【Menu/Exit Key】	Enter or exit current setting.
Right 【Set Key】	Confirm current setting.
Up/Down	Select settings or parameters up and down.

LED and buzzer

There are two LED lights: blue means ready, red means error.

The following combinations of different lights and buzzer show different statuses of the laminator.

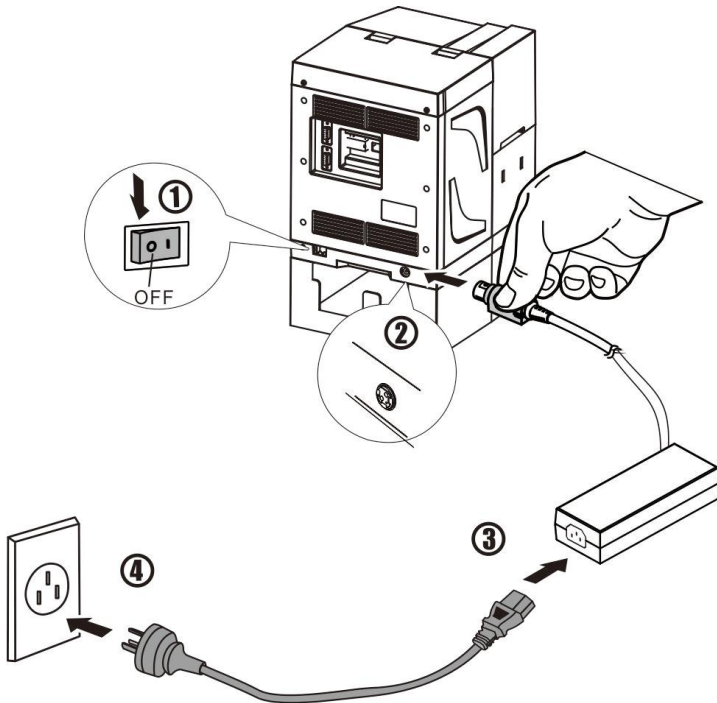

1.5 Attaching Power

■ Connecting the Power Cables

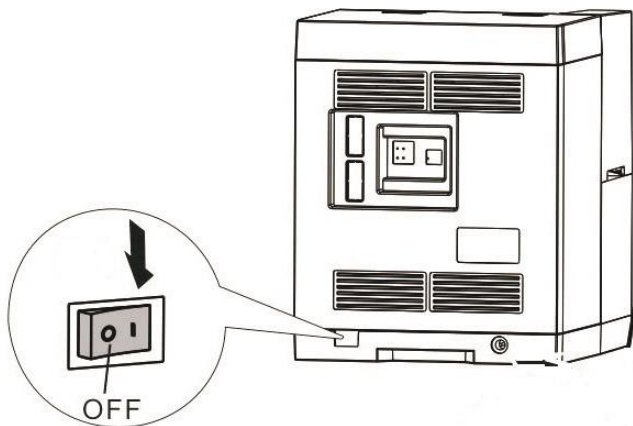
- (1) Make sure the laminator is powered off. ①
- (2) Connect the power adapter to the laminator. ②
- (3) Connect the power cord to the power adapter. ③
- (4) Connect the power cord to the power socket. ④



■ Power on and Power off

Press the power switch: "I", switch on the laminator.

Press the power switch: "O", switch off the laminator.



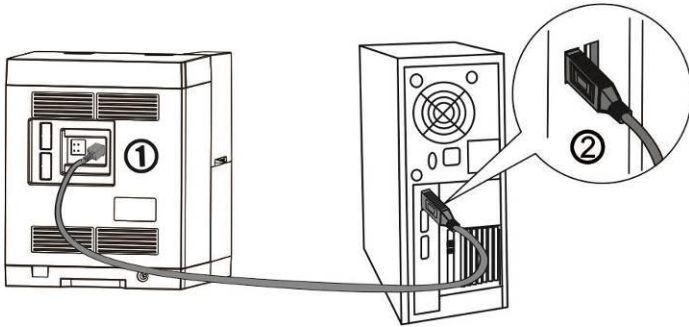
Please disconnect the power cord if the laminator will not be used for a long time. If the laminator is used with DASCOM retransfer equipment, turn on the laminator before turning on the retransfer equipment.

1.6 Connecting to Computer

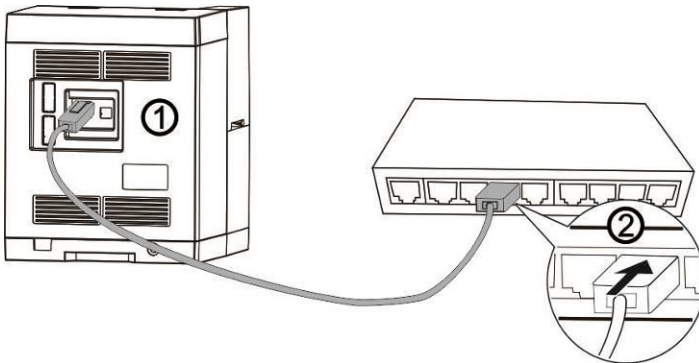
The standard On-board ports of this laminator are a USB port and an Ethernet port.

- (1) Ensure your laminator is switch off.
- (2) Insert the interface cable into the corresponding port.
- (3) Connect the other end of the interface cable to the host computer.

■ Connecting to Computer via Ethernet port



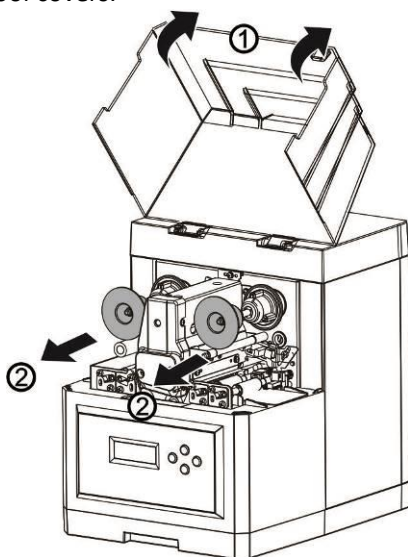
CHAPTER 2 INSTALLATION

2.1 Installing the Film

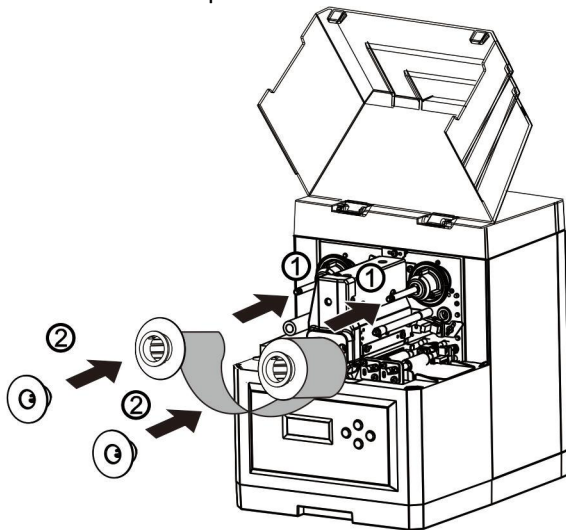


Turn off the laminator before installing the film.

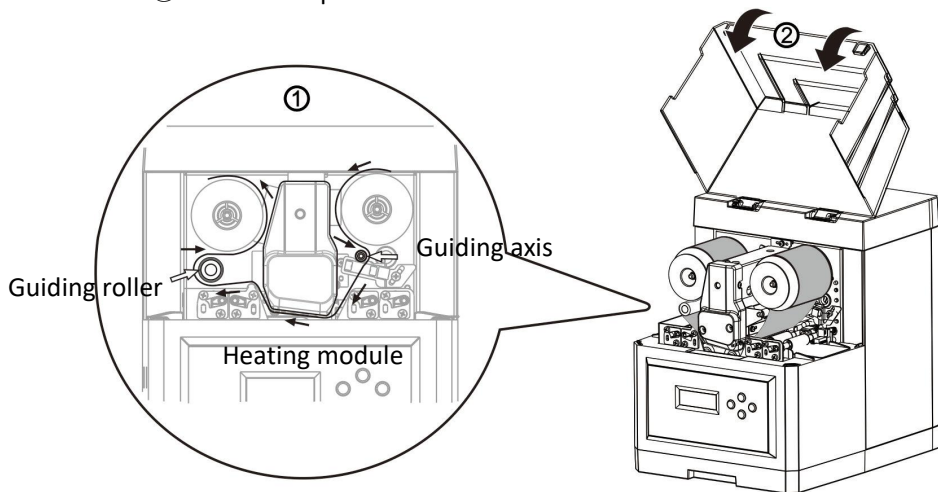
- 1、 ① Open the top cover.
- ② Take out 2 spool covers.



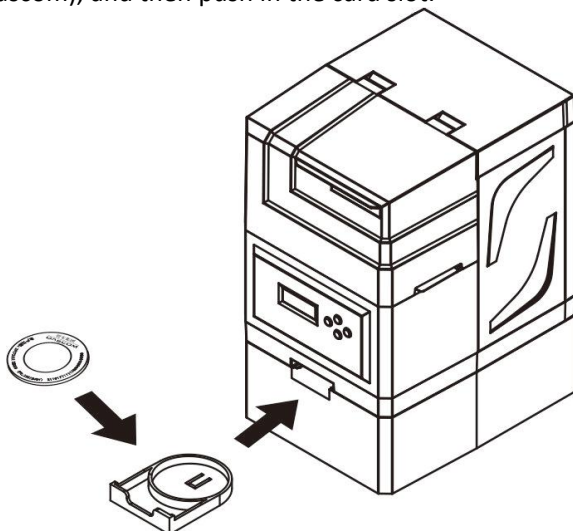
- 2、① Locate the new film into 2 spool poles. (Note: The one facing the laminator on the left side is the rewind pole.)
- ② Put 2 spool covers back in place.



- 3、① Adjust the film according to the arrow direction as shown in below figure, ensure the film passes through the guiding axis, heating module and guiding roller without wrinkles.
- ② Close the top cover.

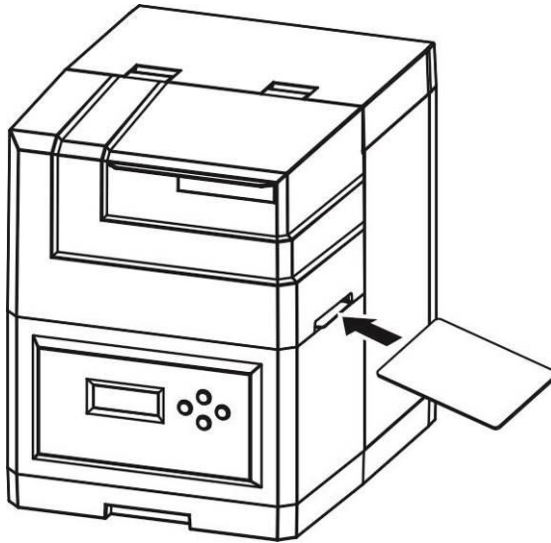


- 4、 Place RFID recognition tag that is attached to the film into the card slot on the base (to identify whether the used film is genuine from Dascom), and then push in the card slot.



2.2 Loading the Card

Load the card through the slot, one at a time.

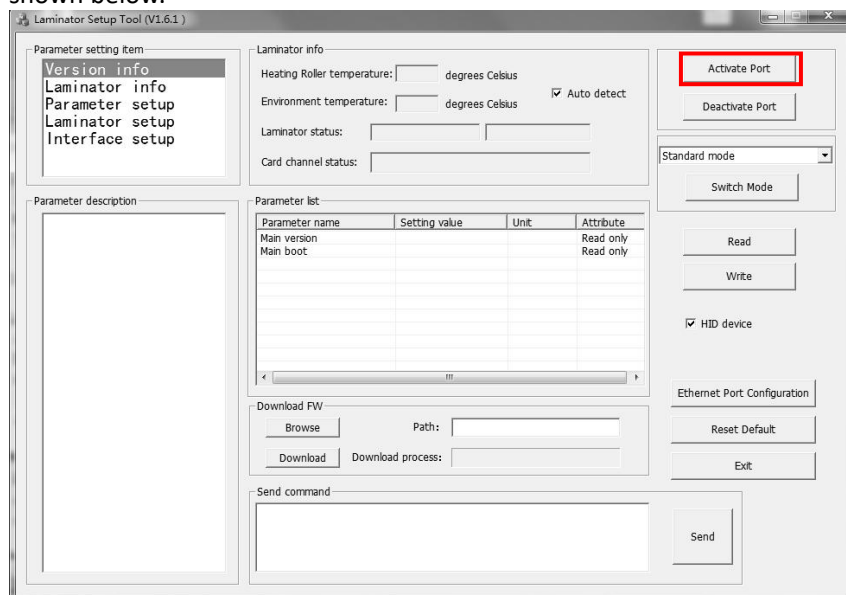


2.3 Changing the Setting

Directly click the setup tool to change the settings. No installation is needed.

Menu setup

When the laminator is in the normal mode, **【Auto detect】** and **【HID device】** are selected, click **【Activate Port】** to enter menu setup, as shown below.



How to change the parameters in the menu via the setup tool :

- 1、 Select the required setting item in the **【Parameter setting item】** .
- 2、 Select the required parameter in the **【Parameter list】** , and double click the corresponding **【Setting value】** to do the change. When changing the parameter, please pay attention to the annotation for the setting range.

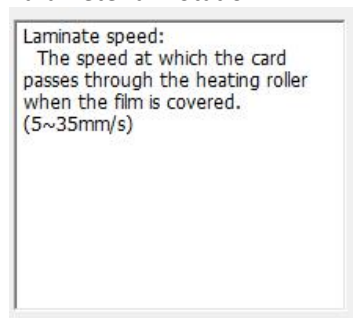

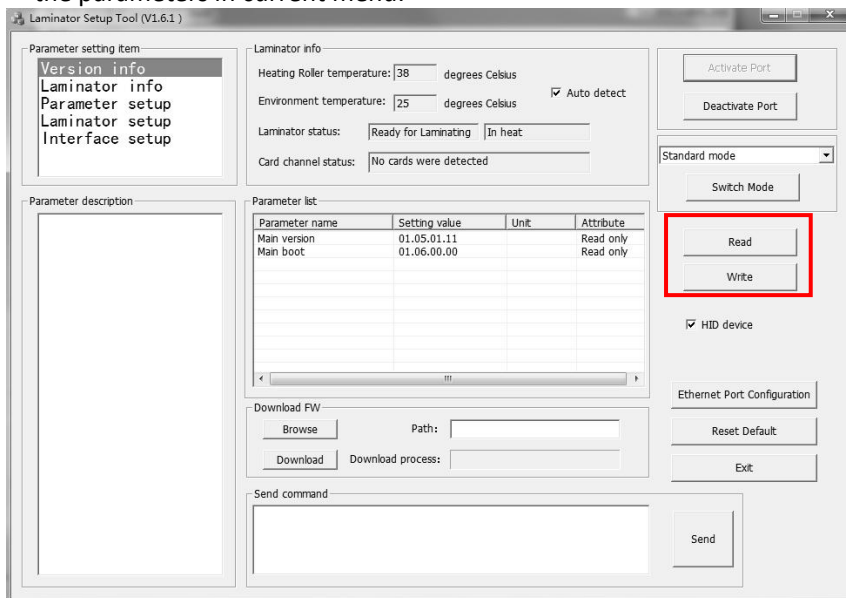

3、Click **【Write】** to save the change. You can also click **【Read】** to view the parameters in current menu.



2.4 Updating the Firmware

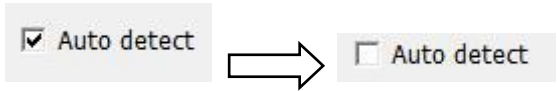
Holding **【Menu】** and **【Setting】** keys while powering on the laminator, to enter FW update mode.

LCD will shown as below.

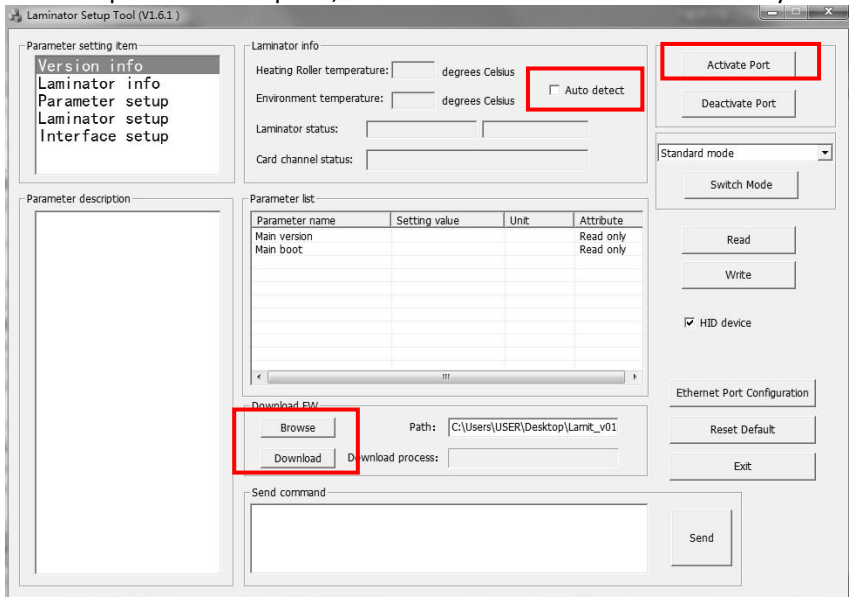


How to update the FW via the setup tool :

- 1、 Cancel the selection of **【Auto detect】** .



- 2、 Click **【Activate port】** .
- 3、 Click **【Browse】** to select the installation path.
- 4、 Click **【Download】** to start updating FW. When the update process is complete, the laminator will restart automatically.



2.5 Optimizing the Laminate Quality

To optimize the laminate quality, you can change the heating roller temperature and laminating speed according to the type of the card, via LCD panel or setup tool.

1、 Setup the heating roller temperature:

- ① Change Normal Mode to User Mode (please refer to Chapter 3.2).
- ② Press **【▼】** key until the LCD displays **【Laminate Parm Setup】** , and then press the right key.
- ③ Press **【▼】** key until the LCD displays **【Heater Temp】** . Press the right key.
- ④ Press **【▼/▲】** key to change current temperature.

2、 Setup the laminate speed:

- ① Change Normal Mode to User Mode (please refer to Chapter 3.2).
- ② Press **【▼】** key until the LCD displays **【Laminate Parm Setup】** , and then press the right key.
- ③ Press **【▼】** key until the LCD displays **【Laminate Speed】**. Press the right key.
- ④ Press **【▼/▲】** key to change current speed.

CHAPTER 3 NORMAL MODE AND USER MODE

You can change between **Normal Mode** and **User Mode** when the laminator is operating.

This section outlines the differences between these two modes and how to switch from one to the other.

3.1 Normal Mode

Normal mode: After start up, the laminator goes into Normal Mode in which the laminator can laminate cards.

In this mode, after you press the **▼Key** for 1 second, the LCD displays the heating roller temperature and environment temperature, as shown below.

Heater Temp:	150°C
Env Temp:	25°C

Normal Mode Message List:

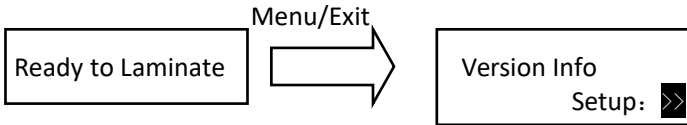
Initialize	The laminator undergoes system diagnostic and initialization. Cards remaining in the laminator from a previous irregular session will be ejected.
Heating	After initialization, the heating roller is heating up to the specified temperature for laminating.
Cooling	When the heating roller temperature is higher than the setting value, the heating roller will cool down.
Ready to laminate	The laminator is awaiting host requests or commands.
Laminating	The laminator is implementing the laminating operation.
Power Save Mode	The laminator is in an energy saving state.

3.2 User Mode

User Mode allows changing the parameters and checking the status.

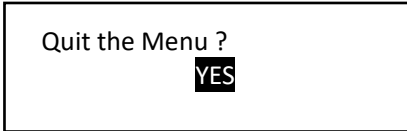
How to change from Normal Mode to User Mode:

After initialization, LCD displays [READY]. Press **Menu/Exit** Key for 1 second then release it. The LCD changes its display to [Version Info], which is the entry menu in User Mode, as shown below.



How to return to Normal Mode from User Mode:

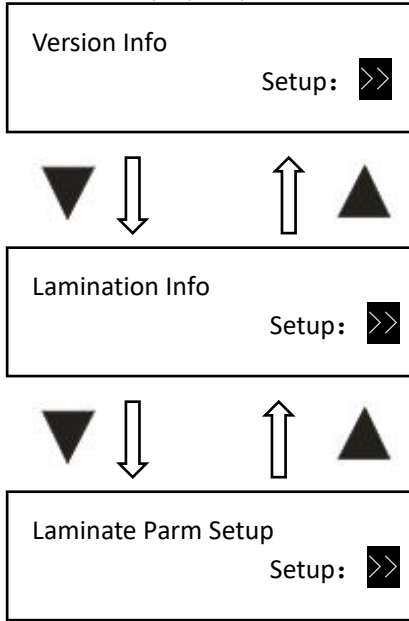
Consecutively press **Menu/Exit Key** until the LCD shows [Quit the Menu]. Then press **Set Key** to return to Normal Mode, as shown below.



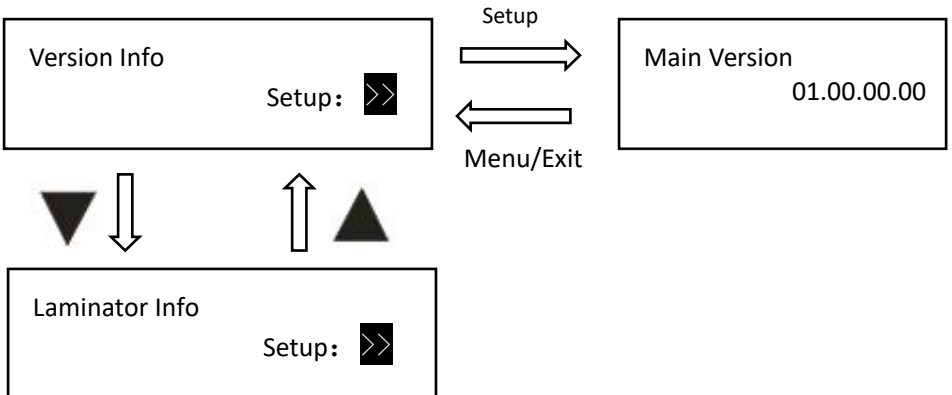
Function of four keys in User Mode:

- **【Menu/Exit Key】** : enter the menu or back to its parent menu
- **【▲】** : previous item
- **【▼】** : next item
- **【Set Key】** : an affirmative response to the second line in the LCD

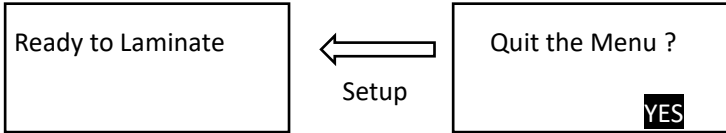
Consecutively pressing ▼/▲ keys scrolls through the various menus. It doesn't mater which arrow key is pressed since the menu loop around. But when the desired menu is displayed, press the **Set key**.



When **SET: >>** appears on the second line of the menu, pressing **Set Key** enters available sub-menus or parameter values. As shown below, the right menu is the sub-menu of the left one.



Consecutively press **Menu/Exit Key** until the LCD shows [Quit the Menu]. Then press **Set Key** to return to Normal Mode, as shown below.



Set Key must be pressed to save the newly changed value. Directly pressing **Menu/Exit Key** or switching off the laminator will not save any newly changed value(s).

■ Version Info

- ◆ Main Version: Version number of Main Firmware.
- ◆ Main Boot: Version number of Main Boot.

■ Laminator Info

- ◆ Card Count: The total number of Cards passed through the Laminator.
- ◆ Total Count: The total amount of Laminates applied.
- ◆ Serial Number: Laminator SN.
- ◆ Model ID: Model ID.



For quality assurance at the factory, it is necessary to run various laminating tests on the laminator. A value of tens or more for Card Count is normal during manufacturing of your laminator.

■ Laminate Parm Setup

- ◆ **Laminate Mode:** Current laminate mode of the laminator. 8 different modes available. Mode 1 \ Mode 2 \ Mode 3 \ Mode 4 \ Mode 5 \ Mode 6 \ Mode 7 \ Mode 8
- ◆ **Heater Temp:** The temperature of the heating roller when laminating.
(Range: 100~180°C, Unit of adjustment: 5°C)
- ◆ **Laminate Speed:** The speed at which the card passes through the heating roller when laminating.
(Range: 5~35mm/s, Unit of adjustment :1mm/s)
- ◆ **Film Feed Speed:** Movement speed of Laminate after Laminate has been applied.
(Range: 9~35mm/s, Unit of adjustment: 1mm/s)
- ◆ **Film Laminate Pos:** After Black Mark detection, distance of Laminate is to be positioned.
(Range-80.0~80.0mm, Unit of adjustment: 0.1mm)
- ◆ **Card Laminate Pos:** Beginning position of Laminate on the Card when applied.
(Range: -10.0~10.0mm, Unit of adjustment: 0.1mm)
- ◆ **Laminate End Pos:** The distance from which the film continues to feed after laminating.
(Range: 0~80.0mm, Unit of adjustment: 0.1mm)
- ◆ **BlackMark Mode:** Used to detect the Black Mark on the Laminate.
Option: Disable \ Enable

- ◆ **BlackMark Detect Speed:** The feeding speed of Laminate when detecting the Black Mark.
(Range : 9~35mm/s, Unit of adjustment: 1mm/s)
- ◆ **Auto Card In:** The waiting time before loading the card when the card is detected.
(Range: 0~10s, Unit of adjustment: 1s)
- ◆ **Auto Laminate:** Turns on when used with DASCOM retransfer equipment and turns off when used alone.
Option: ON \ OFF



You can customize the parameters of the settings for each "Laminate Mode". When exiting the menu, the changed parameters will be saved. Directly select the corresponding "Laminate Mode" for various application.

■ Laminator Setup

- ◆ **Buzzer:** It sounds when there is a failure or alarm.
Option: OFF \ ON
- ◆ **Power Save Mode:** The laminator enters the power save mode after waiting for x minutes, and the temperature of the heating roller will be stable.
Option: Mode 1 \ Mode 2,
(Range: OFF 5~120min, Unit of adjustment: 1min)
- ◆ **Language Setup:** Sets the display font for the current LCD screen.
Option: CHINESE \ ENGLISH
- ◆ **LCD Contrast:** Adjust the contrast of the current LCD screen.
(Default: 128, Range: 0~255)
- ◆ **LCD Backlight:** Turns on or off the screen backlight.
Option: On \ Off

- ◆ **Laminate Type:** The currently recognized Laminate type.

Option: PATCH1 \ OVERLAY1

Setting	Function
Mode 1	In standby mode, it can be set to enter power save mode. The heating roller temperature drops to about 100°C.

CHAPTER 4 TROUBLESHOOTING

4.1 Warning Messages and Troubleshooting

This laminator is designed for minimal user intervention. Occasionally, the LCD displays messages to advise users to take corrective actions.

After clearing an error, press SET Key to initialize the laminator and [Ready] will be displayed.

- Warning/Error List

Display	Solution
Push Set Key	Press the SET Key once.
No Film	Check whether the film is installed or cut off.
Film Jam	Remove the film and reinstall it, to ensure correct installation.
Film End	The transfer film has been used up. Replace a new one.
Feeder Card Jam	Pressing Set Key as LCD display shown may eject jammed card. If the fault is still not cleared, turn the rollers manually to clear jammed card.
Invalid Parameter	Check whether each parameter of the menu setup item is within the setting range.
Heat Roll Failure	Check whether the heating roller is installed, and then contact your re-seller's service support team.
Device High Temp	Power off the laminator immediately.
HR Power Err	Contact your re-seller's service support team to report Error Code(s) displayed on the lower right of LCD.
Call Support	Contact your re-seller's service support team to report Error Code(s) displayed on the lower right of LCD.
